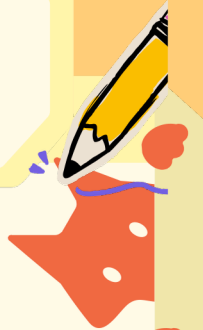


HALLWAYS & HIGHLIGHTS

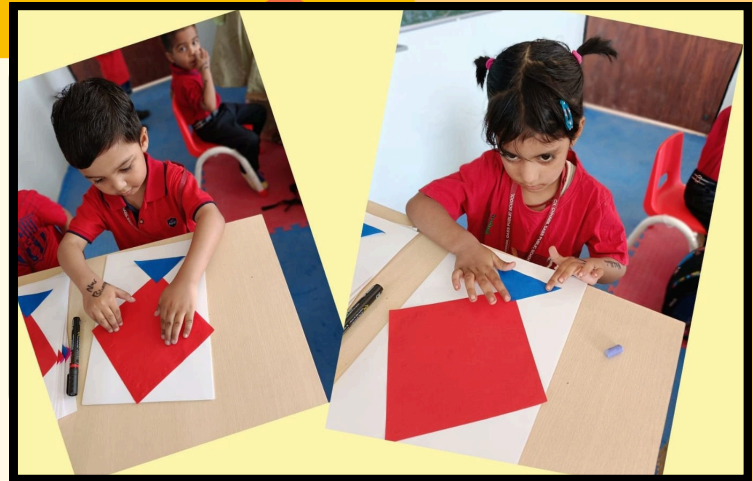

HINDI RHYME COMPETITION

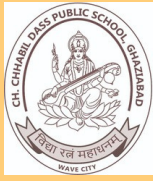

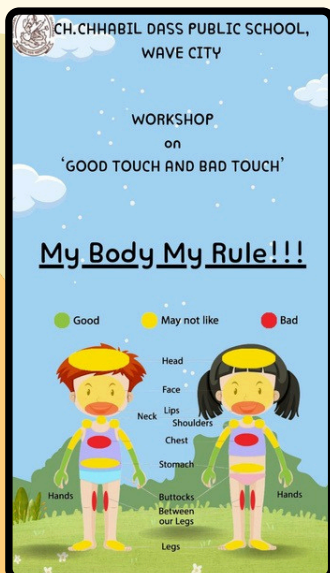
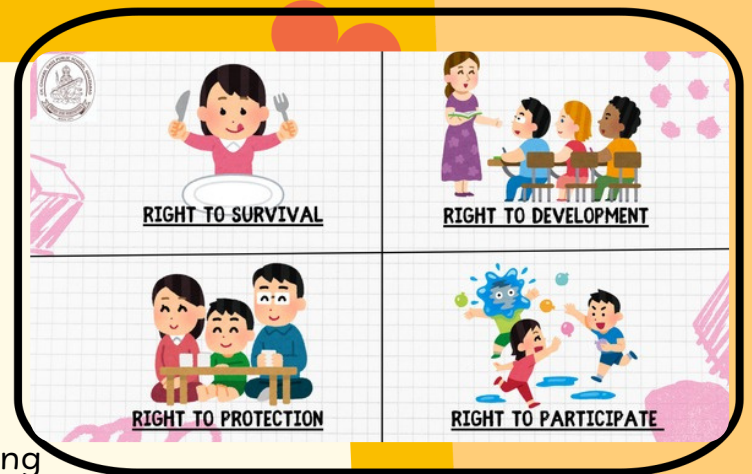

ENGLISH RHYME COMPETITION

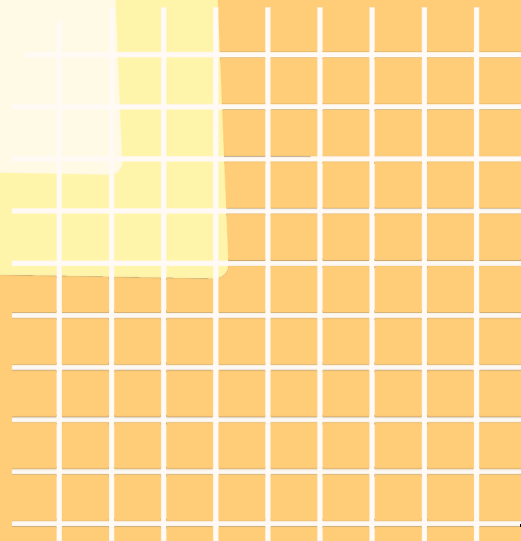


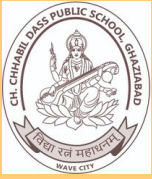

Workshop 1 " Girl's Health and Hygiene"

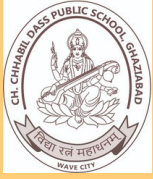

"Hindi and English Debate"

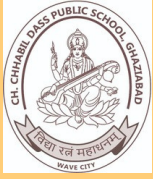

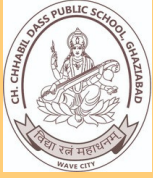
RAKSHA BANDHAN

Air Quality and Water Quality Monitoring Update

Air Quality Index (AQI)

The recent Air Quality Index (AQI) readings for Particulate Matter (PM) have been recorded in the range of 10-20, within the safe limits for outdoor activities. This indicates that the air quality is healthy, posing minimal risks to the well-being of individuals in the school environment.

Water Quality Monitoring

We have also tested the water quality in various locations, with the following results:

Normal Tap Water: Total Dissolved Solids (TDS) = 230 ppm

R.O. Filter 1: TDS = 117 ppm

R.O. Filter 2: TDS = 117 ppm
